**GET YOUR PIECE OF THE MONEY PIE**

When you file your annual income tax and benefit return, you may be eligible to receive benefits or credits, which could include:

- GST/HST Credit
- Canada Child Benefit
- School Supplement Benefit
- Healthy Smiles, Clear Vision
- Canada Learning Bond

For help preparing your income tax and benefit return, the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program (CVITP) may be able to assist you. This free program is available to those with modest income and simple tax situations.

## GET YOUR PIECE OF THE MONEY PIE

Depending on your personal situation, you may be eligible to receive credits and benefits by simply filing your annual income tax and benefit return.

### Did you know ...

- A single person could receive up to \$1,894 for the **Working Income Tax Benefit**. \*Based on the assumption that there is some working income.
- You could qualify for the **GST/HST credit**.
- Adults and children with a disability could be eligible for a non-refundable tax credit which reduces the amount of income tax they may have to pay.
- Parents could receive up to \$6,496 annually for each child by applying for the **Canada Child Benefit**.
- Parents with school aged children could receive the **School Supplement** benefit of \$100 per child.
- Your child could qualify for the **Healthy Smiles, Clear Vision** plan, New Brunswick's dental and vision program for children of low-income families.
- Your child could qualify for the **Canada Learning Bond**, a federal program that offers up to \$2,000 for education after high school for children of low-income families.
- Before the year they turn 60, adults and children with a disability who have qualified for the **Disability Tax Credit**, can open a Registered Disability Savings Plan and could receive up to \$3,500 in **Canada Disability Savings Grants** and \$1,000 in **Canada Disability Savings Bonds** from the Government of Canada annually.
