

Prosper Canada online course: Financial Literacy for Facilitators

This online course is designed to help front-line practitioners to gain the skills and knowledge required to become financially empowered and to successfully deliver financial literacy workshops in your community. The course provides an orientation to the content, facilitation basics and explores how to adapt the Prosper Canada Centre for Financial Literacy's curriculum to the needs, context, and interests of vulnerable and low-income Canadians.

You can log into the course at any time and work at your own pace, as long as you complete all course activities before the **course** closes after 8 weeks. Throughout the course, once you complete a Module and its Quiz, you will receive access to the next Module. The course takes approximately 15 to 20 hours to complete.
