

DISABILITY POPULATION

89.6% of programs were available to individuals regardless of disability or health condition. A small number of programs were aimed at specific disability popualations such as cancer (2.2%), diabetes (2.2%) and spinal cord injury (0.7%)

FINANCIAL CAPABILITY

The majority of programs focused on accessing government benefits. Only 11 programs addressed financial education.


HEALTHCARE PRACTITIONERS

All of the financial programs available for healthcare and social care practioners exclusively addressed how to fill out the Disability Tax Credit application for clients.

**** FUTURE RESEARCH

Future research avenues include qualitative analysis of existing financial services as well as a scoping review of financial program effectiveness.
