

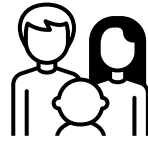

Working Canadians get a boost from the Canada workers benefit (CWB)



Most low income individuals can get up to

\$1,381



Most low income families can get up to

\$2,379

Individuals and families who are in the workforce and earn a low income may be eligible for the CWB.



Claim the CWB when you do your taxes.



The amount you can expect to receive depends on your **income** and the province or territory **where you live**. If you qualify for the disability tax credit, you may be eligible for a supplement of up to \$713.



If you think your income will stay the same, you can receive up to half of your benefit in **advance payments** instead of waiting for tax time!



If your income increases during the year, you can call us and we'll adjust your advance payments.

How to claim the CWB and apply for advance payments

1. Do your taxes and follow the instructions in your certified tax software. If you file a paper return, fill out Schedule 6.
2. Apply for advance payments online through My Account or by mailing your completed Form RC201, Canada Workers Benefit Advance Payments. Applications are due by August 31.
